The kickoff dinner was held in a tent at Elkhorn View Estates at 192nd

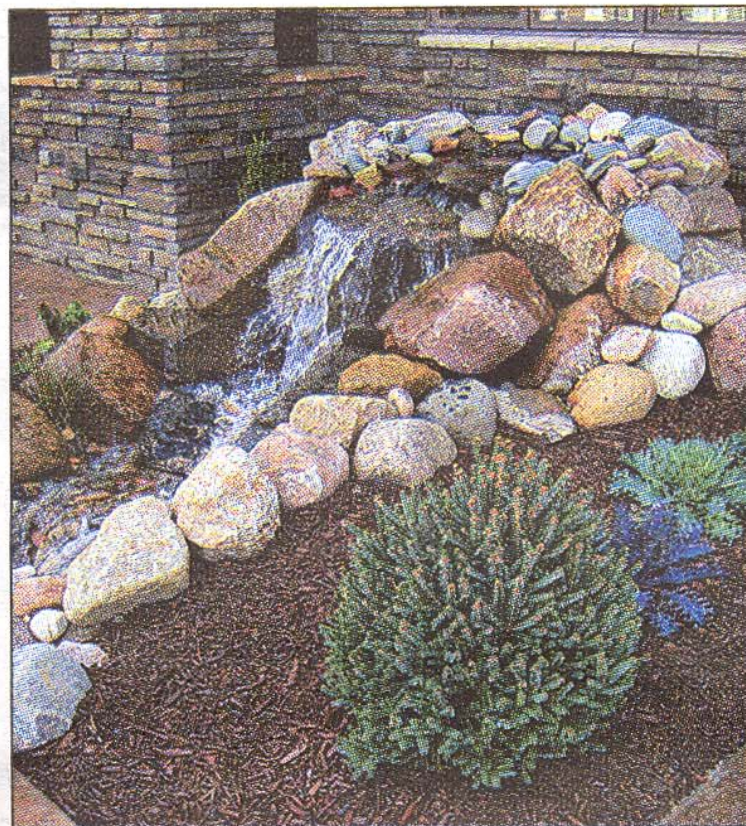
and Binney Sts. A tour of the four luxury homes followed.
